We noticed in the news last week, there is a proposal to hire nurses for all the schools to help with the COVID crisis. We know this crisis is overwhelming with all the other issues playing into a successful school year. Here is an idea we have that might save millions of dollars!!

We have been working the with districts prior to Covid to provide mobile Telemedicine video conferencing carts for schools. With the mobile medicine carts, a nurse at one location can see the students/faculty without traveling to the other school. The telemed cart is equipped with video conferencing, medical scopes, and a laptop, to allow the nurse to see the patient quickly and assess the situation from anywhere. Remember, this is a one-time expenditure, with all costs for three years included, compared to the ongoing costs of additional personnel. ALSO, it is a fully functioning video conferencing system capable of providing instruction. This means that if the school(s) close, this video system could be used to deliver live instruction with both an interactive panel AND video conferencing!
